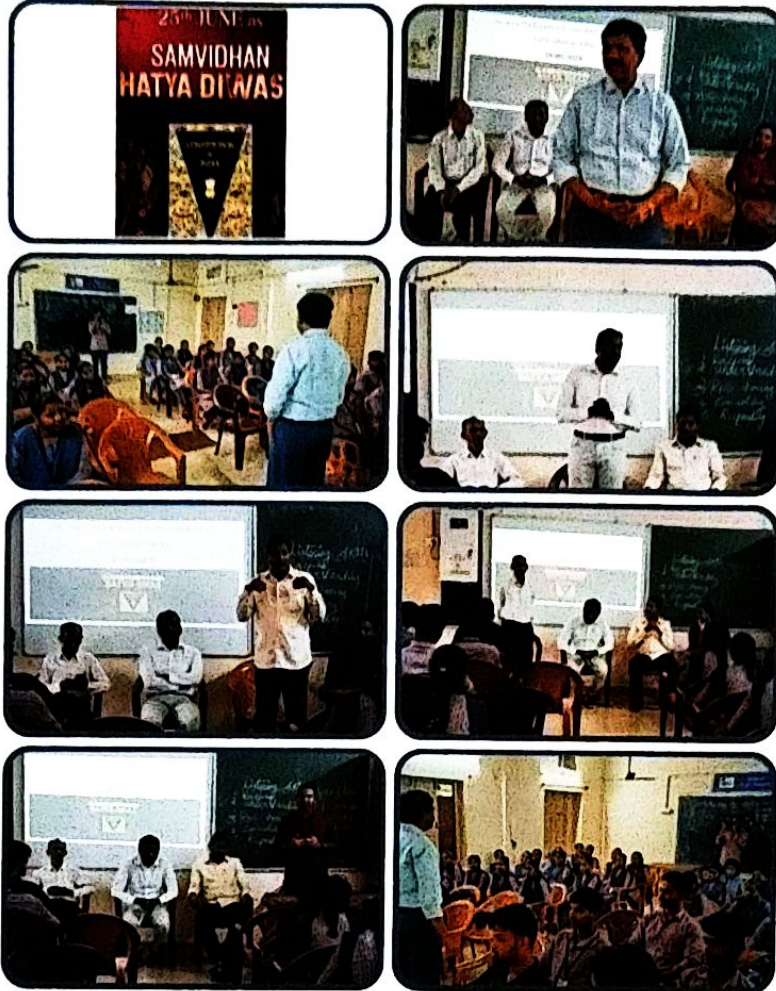




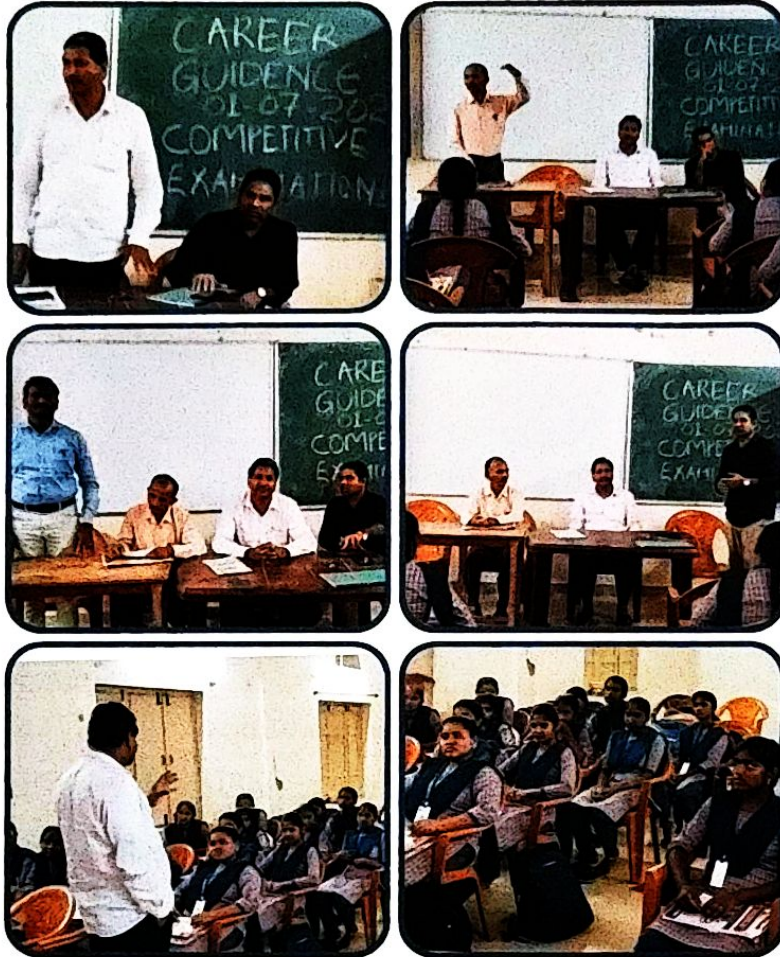
## CELEBRATED SAMVIDHAN HATYA DIWAS

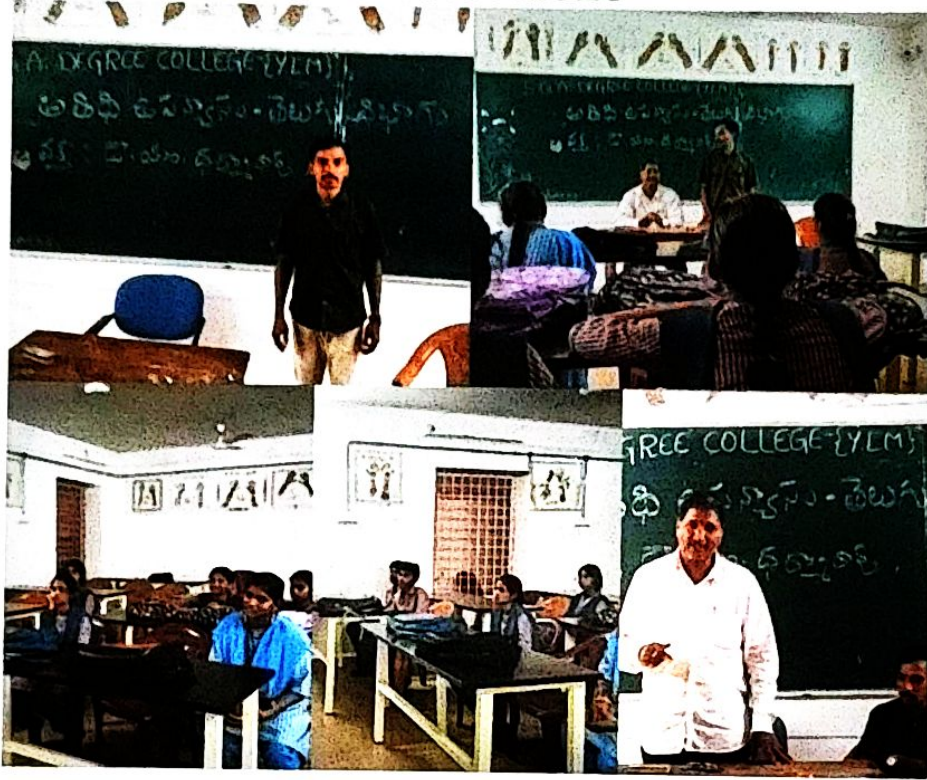
## Career Guidance on Competitive Exams
