HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE



S.G.A. Government Degree College was established in the year 1987 by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The college has offered two courses namely B.A with H.E.P (History, Economics, Politics) and B.Com (General) from the academic year 1987-88.

Two new courses namely B.Sc (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry) and B.Sc (Botany, Zoology, Chemistry) were started in the Academic Year 1997-98.

A restructured course, BSc (Mathematics, Physics, Computer Science), was started in the academic year 2006-07. A new restructured course B.A (History, Economics, Rural Industrialisation) was started from the academic year 2011-12 replacing the conventional B. A (History, Economics, Politics) course. The college was named after eminent social reformer, educationalist and modern age poet Sri Gurajada Appa Rao. He belongs to a village Sarvariddi Rayavaram, which is 10 kilometres away from Yellamanchili. The college is most accessible and is catering to the educational needs of rural students in the Visakhapatnam district of North Coastal Andhra Pradesh. The college is located in Yellamanchili. Yellamanchili is a Municipality and is well connected by road and rail to the port city of Visakhapatnam. The nearest airport is Visakhapatnam.

Yellamanchili has a rich historical background. During the British regime, it was one of the few important taluq headquarters. It had a prominent place during Satavahana's and Gupta's regime. During Samudragupta's period, this area is known as Devarashtra.

Venugopalaswamy and Verabhadraswamy temples were constructed by Chalukyan minister in the village kokkirapilli in Yellamanchili mandal. The evidence of existence of Yellamanchili in Stone Age is preserved in the Department of archaeology, Andhra University. Dimili, a nearby village to Yellamanchili is the birth place of modern famous poets Sri Sri and Arudra.

The college is affiliated with Andhra University, Visakhapatnam. It is co-educational and is offering five (05) undergraduate courses, namely B.A (History, Economics, Rural Industrialisation), B.Com, B.Sc (Maths, Physics, Chemistry), BSc (Maths, Physics, Computer Science) and BSc (Botany, Zoology, Chemistry). The total number of students pursuing the five undergraduate courses is 545. All the students are hailing from rural areas. More than 60% of students are female students. 70% of students are SC/ST/OBC students and they hail from economically weaker sections. At present, the college has 22 regular faculty members.

The college has a land area of 6.27 acres. There is a big playground developed by the Sports Authority of Andhra Pradesh. The college has state of the art gymnasium. It has 11 classrooms and 04 science labs, 01 commerce lab and 01 English language lab. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University Study Centre is located in the campus. The college has a library with 7223 text books, reference books and Journals and e-corner.

The college was accredited with 'A' grade (CGPA-3.03) in Cycle-II accreditation in the year 2015 by NAAC, Bangalore. A new PG programme (M.Com) was started in the academic year 2017-18. The college was sanctioned financial assistance of Rs. Two crores under "Infrastructure component by Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA).

Another PG program M.Sc (Organic Chemistry) was sanctioned in the Academic Year 2022-23.

Rules regarding the award of Scholarships, Fee concession etc.

Extract from: Rule No. 219 (K) of Andhra Pradesh Education Rules. The concessions granted are liable to be withdrawn in all cases of misconduct. Extract from the proceedings of D.P.I: C.No. 2044/T 4.3/68, Dt. 25-6-68. "It has been decided by the Government that Scholarships sanctioned under various schemes shall be withdrawn/suspended/terminated/cancelled, as the case may be irrespective of their nature when scholars go on strike or indulge in activities "subversive of discipline or public peace and order. This step has to be taken to induce a sense of discipline among scholarship holders. They being the beneficiaries out of public funds can rightly be compelled to behave better and set an example to others".



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

1. Every Student must invariably wear the college uniform.
2. No student shall be permitted to enter the classes after 10.00 AM.
3. Biometric attendance is mandatory.
4. Attendance is given in class at the time the teacher takes the roll call.
5. Students are advised to park their vehicles only in parking place.
6. Students must carry college identification cards on all working days.
7. Students' appearance outside the lecture halls during classes is considered serious.
8. Books, laboratory equipment or other property of the college entrusted to their care by each student should be consumed in good condition. Or in case they lost them or damaged, they need to be replaced or refunded
9. Students should be assisted in keeping classrooms and premises clean and tidy.
10. Ragging, clashing with other students and teachers, vandalizing walls, throwing junk paper, loitering, causing trouble, or holding informal meetings or for entertainment at the college or collecting money for any purpose within the college without the written permission of the Principal are punishable offenses
11. Students who are guilty of going to other colleges to participate in undisciplined acts such as organizing demonstrations and strikes should be punished accordingly.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

12. Students should not hold meetings to criticize the conduct of the university or authorities of the college. Such meetings are considered unlawful and the Principal might take action and if she considers it too serious, she may report to the Syndicate under section 3 of Chapter VII of the code of rustication.

13. Violence against oneself or others or direct or indirect coercion of students, such as demonstrating hunger strike for enforcing their will on the college or university, are punishable by the college or reported to the syndicate.

14. The name of the college should not be used in any publication and given to the press in any manner without the permission of the Principal.

15. No class or group of students may participate in any public activity without the permission of the principal.

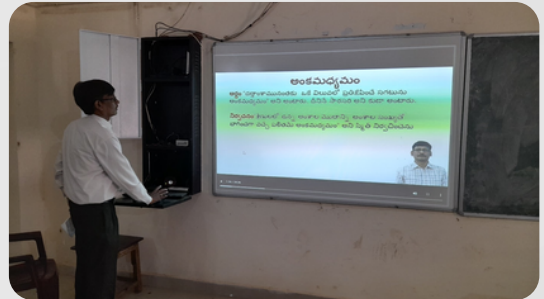
16. Class representatives are unanimously elected by the students of the respective class. Each class/group shall have one class representative.

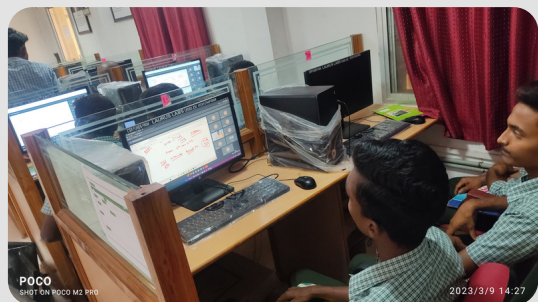

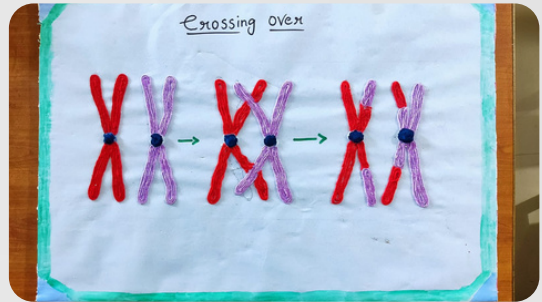

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Jawahar Knowledge Centre: (JKC) was initiated in 2005 by the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Andhra Pradesh as a reliable solution to the problem of unemployment faced by students studying non-professional courses in Degree colleges. The increasing prominence of India on the global map and the explosion of IT opportunities have created the need for placement assistance cells that would improve the career prospects of our students. The JKC's with a dedicated focus on transforming the existing unemployable talent pool in Government Degree Colleges into an industry friendly one is striving with commitment and sincerity of purpose.

NSS:

The NSS Unit of this college is established in 1993 with the strength of 100 volunteers. Present this college is having three NSS units in campus conducting many activities for welfare of college and society. The NSS wings of SGA Govt. Degree College, Yellamanchili play a very active role in almost all the programmes and activities of the college like International Yoga Day, Adoption of Villager, in conducting Free Medical camps, Blood Donation camps, AIDS Awareness Rally, World Unity Day, Independence Day, NSS Day, Republic Day, International Women's Day, Gandhi Jayanthi, Peace Rallies, College Day Celebration etc., Apart from all these programmes, the NSS volunteers will take part in all the cultural competitions like Inter collegiate cultural Festival, NSS Youth Festival and also participate in National Integration Campus. These will be Special Camping programmes in adopted villages for one week.

WEC :

Women Empowerment Cell is designed to empower women socially, economically, politically and legally with a focus on promoting decision making. It conducts various activities and arranges Guest Lectures to accelerate the academic enhancement, leadership development and cultural enrichment in the lives of young women.



Anti Ragging Committee: The ragging is strictly prohibited in our college and taken measures of prohibition and prevention as per UGC REGULATION 2009. The principal of the college is constituted Anti-ragging committee for prevention as well as the prohibition of ragging in the college campus which is to create “ragging free “within the campus and as well as to create and make a “joyful atmosphere” in our college campus.

Career Guidance Cell:

The career guidance cell provides relevant academic and career information to enable Students to make informed decisions along the way. Our focus is to provide learning / training opportunities in the areas of academic, career and personal / social development and to prepare students to meet their future challenges. The career guidance cell of the college is constituted with a placement officer and faculty members of the college to provide necessary guidance and information to the students in shaping the future career. The team keeps up to date with employment trends and options to ensure quality advice to students.

The Career Guidance Cell provides commendable services in areas of Campus Interviews; Job Placements and training programmes for our students that enable them to develop applicable skills in the competitive job market.

Grievance Redressal Cell :

Grievances and Redressal cell is constituted in the college as per the regulations of UGC. The College has a Grievance Redressal Cell to redress the grievances of its stakeholders. The Cell enables a student to express feelings by initiating and pursuing the grievance procedure in accordance with the rules and regulations of the College. “Grievance Redressal Cell” enquires and analyses the nature and pattern of the grievances in a strictly confidential manner.



Red Ribbon Club: The Red Ribbon Club (RRC) of SGA Government Degree College, Yellamanchili is encouraged to learn about safe and healthy lifestyles. The RRC promotes access to information on healthy life and voluntary blood donation. They create and provide opportunities to the zeal of volunteerism among youth to contribute to the control and prevention of HIV&AIDS. The Red Ribbon Club is a voluntary on-campus intervention program for students. The programme organized by RRC addresses the knowledge, attitude and behavior of the youths in the interrelated areas of Voluntary Blood Donation, HIV & AIDS, as demanded by their age, environment, and lifestyle.

District Resource Center:

Government Degree Colleges are spread across the state in all the districts. Most of them are located in rural and semi urban areas. They mostly serve students from poor and underprivileged sections of society. The students of colleges located in rural areas face disadvantages like infrastructural and teacher shortages, lack of exposure to modern educational atmosphere and inadequate background support. They need additional support. Although each district has about 5 to 10 Government Degree Colleges and they are working as total individual entities so far. Pooling and sharing of resources will benefit students of all colleges' especially rural colleges.

The Government Degree Colleges in each district, therefore, were networked with a select government college in the district, called the District Resource Centre (DRC). Year long activities are planned and implemented by the colleges of the district under the DRC for the benefit of the students in the subject and in general areas. The DRCs are expected tentatively to compensate some of the disadvantages faced by the students of all colleges, especially in the rural colleges.

COLLEGE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (CPDC) CONSTITUTION OF CPDC:

The Principal (President) concerned will nominate all the members in consultation with the staff council of the college

The lecturer – members should be one senior lecturer and two lecturers from GCTA – AP, GCGTA-AP.

The members will elect the secretary of the CPDC.

The usual term of a member of the committee is two years. The principal and lecturer will cease to be members if they are transferred or retired. The new principal will

automatically become the president. The parent member will lose his or her membership when the studies of their ward are completed. The vacancies of members will be filled in by the president from time to time.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To create a suitable environment and a mechanism for community participation in the planning and development of college without interfering with the rules and regulations of functioning.
2. To create a mechanism whereby public contributions can be mobilized for the development of the college.
3. To enable the community to advise and assist in introducing relevant courses of study in the college based on the needs of the area and to improve the quality of education.
4. To act as an active medium between the college and the community for mutual benefit.
5. To help creating the congenial climate for academic, cultural, social service oriented activities.



POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE CPDC:

1. To work for the furtherance of the objectives of the CPDC.
2. To prepare a detailed plan, with annual budgetary allocations, for college development and to execute developmental programmes.
3. To generate a separate CPDC fund and to utilize the CPDC fund solely for the benefit of the students.
4. To operate money-matters by opening a separate account for CPDC fund in a nationalized bank.

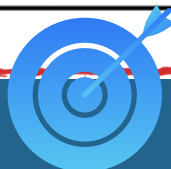




FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAM AT GDC NKP

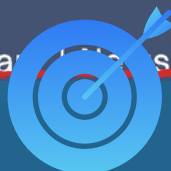

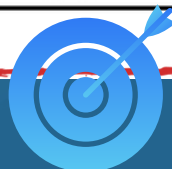
On 24-02-2023, Department of Botany organized a field visit to the near by areas for the students to identify the plants and their scientific names.

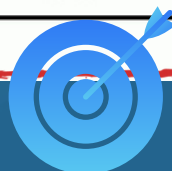

Kum Sandhya won Bronze medal in the state level hockey championships women.

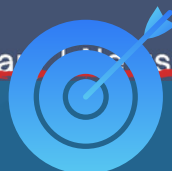

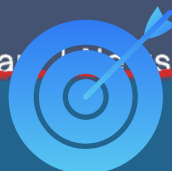

The NSS unit of the college joined with the students and distributed fruits to the patients in the nearby Government Hospital on 17-02-2023. The students actively participated in the social service.

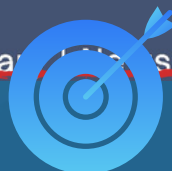

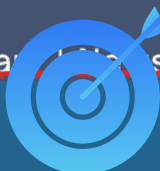
